SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE ST. LOUIS AREA, MISSOURI AND ILLINOIS

LOCATION: St. Louis is located on the east-central border of Missouri. The city is situated on the western bank of the Mississippi River, just downstream from its junction with the Missouri River. East St. Louis, in Illinois, lies east across the river. The landscape is a gently rolling one, and elevations are around 500 feet above sea level.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 58% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 44% in December, to a high of 70% in July. The year's lowest temperature should be close to -5°, and the highest should be near 100°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be essentially the same as actual ones. St. Louis has a continental version of the standard mid-latitude four-season climate. Its location in the middle of the continent gives it a wide range of temperatures, unmodified by any nearby large bodies of water. Summers are moderate in length, sunny, and hot to very hot. Winters are also moderate in length, still fairly sunny, and cold to very cold. Spring and autumn are seasons of transition, with spells of cooler weather alternating with spells of warmer weather.
