## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE OCEAN CITY RESORT AREA, MARYLAND

LOCATION: Ocean City, Maryland's only Atlantic coast resort area, is located on that coast in extreme northeastern Maryland, just south of the Delaware border. The town is situated on a 10-mile long barrier island, separated from the mainland by Assawoman and Isle of Wight Bays. The area's chief attractions are its white-sand beaches, a three-mile-long boardwalk, Assateague Island National Seashore (which see), deep-sea fishing, boating, golf, and other resort activities. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level. The area draws heavily from the Baltimore and Washington metropolitan areas.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 60% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 52% in December and January, to a high of 65% in the June through September season. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 10°, and the highest should be near 95°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 5° warmer than actual ones during the mid-summer months, and up to 3° cooler than actual ones during the spring and autumn seasons. A third of the days will be clear and sunny all day, with October (41%) leading the pack. Even during mid-winter, the afternoons will almost always warm to above the freezing point—despite the fact that half the nights will drop below that point.
