COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 77% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 72% in September, to a high of 85% in March and April. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 64°, and the highest should be near 93°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be from 1° (January and February) to 7° (June through September) warmer than actual ones. The area has the standard Caribbean tropical two-season year-with a unique twist. The rainy season runs from May through November, with a noticeable drop in precipitation in July. The dry season is only a little drier than the rainy one, and runs from December through April. There is only a slight change in the length of the daylight period from one season to another, and not much of a change in temperatures--about six degrees. The average change in temperature from day to night (about 11°) is almost twice as great. The Northeast Trades blow onshore most of the year, and afternoon humidity is high.
