COMMENTS: The area has a monsoon-tropical climate. There is a distinct wet season (April through October) that is the product of the Southwest Monsoon, and a distinct dry season (November through March) that is associated with the Northeast Monsoon. The rainy season rains often come as part of frontal disturbances, and are frequently accompanied by severe thunderstorms. Humidity is high, and the sensible temperature (the one you actually feel) is ten or more degrees higher than the already high actual temperature. Some amount of rain (even if only a trace) will fall on about two days out of five. During the January through April period, spells of weather known as "*crachin*" show up with some regularity. These last from 3 to 5 days, and are characterized by low, overcast skies or heavy fog. There will normally be a very light drizzle, but very little actual rain. There is little wind, and the air tends to stagnate. Sea temperatures apply to the coast near Hai Phong.

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
