SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE CHURCHILL AREA (MANITOBA), CANADA

LOCATION: Churchill is located on the shores of Hudson's Bay in northeastern Manitoba. It is situated near the mouth of the Churchill River, right in the middle of a polar-bear migration route. During September and October, dozens of polar bear roam within the town itself. One of the world's major polar-bear denning areas is not too far away, in the lowlands of the Broad and Owl Rivers. There is no road access to Churchill. Most visitors arrive by rail (the Hudson Bay Line) or air. A few hardy souls arrive by canoe. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level in this flat and treeless tundra.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 40% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 20% in October, to a high of 51% in July. The year's lowest temperature should be close to -42°, and the highest should be near 86°. Sensible summer afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be a degree or two cooler than actual ones. Summers are restricted to July and August, and the long afternoons are cool to mild. Winters are long, gloomy, and very cold. Temperatures will drop below zero most days from late November through early April. Snow falls in every month except July and August, and flurries are not rare even during those two months.
