SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE WINDSOR AREA, ONTARIO

LOCATION: Windsor is located in extreme southern Ontario, just across the Detroit River from the Michigan city of Detroit. It actually lies south of Detroit (an interesting bit of trivia). Unlike Detroit, Windsor has a viable and relatively safe downtown area. Plus, it has a casino. Elevations are about 625 feet above sea level. Windsor is connected to Detroit by both a bridge and a tunnel.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 53% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 30% in December, to a high of 69% in July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to -6° on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 95° on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be pretty much the same as actual ones. The Windsor area probably gets as mild a climate as can be found in eastern Canada. Winters run from the middle of November through the first week in April, but most afternoons will warm to above freezing at some time-although not necessarily by much. Below-zero temperatures will occur perhaps three or four times each winter-usually during an Arctic cold snap. The best weather comes from May through September.
