SUNSHINE GUIDE TO SARAJEVO AND THE DINARIC ALPS, BOSNIA

LOCATION: Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia, is centrally located in that country. The city is situated on the Bosna River, a tributary of the Danube. Elevations are some 1,800 feet above sea level, in a countryside that is hilly and frequently quite steep. Sarajevo was the site of the 1984 Winter Olympics, and the Dinaric Alps that surround the town rise to more than 6,000 feet in elevation.

COMMENTS: Sarajevo has a standard European four-season year. Precipitation is moderate and is fairly evenly distributed throughout the year. There is a major peak in November, and a minor one in June. Summer afternoons are fairly sunny, particulary in July and August. Humidities are moderate and afternoon temperatures are from warm to hot. Summer nights are cool and dewy. Winter afternoons are short, cloudy, and cold. In November, December, and January, you will not see the sun on two days out of five. This drops to one day in five in February and March. Snow flurries and snowfalls can be expected any time from November into early April. The ground will be snow-covered about half the days in December and January, and a third of the days in February and March. The surrounding mountains will be colder, cloudier, and wetter.
