SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE VENICE AREA, ITALY

LOCATION: Venice (Venezia) is located at the head of the Adriatic Sea in northeastern Italy. The city is situated on several islands in the lagoon of Veneta. A series of barrier islands (including the famous Lido) protects the lagoon from the sea. The main island is connected to the mainland (and the airport and train station) by a causeway. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level—and occasionally below it.

COMMENTS: Venice has a four-season year. Snow flurries occur on and off during the winter months, but the waters of the lagoon keep the piazzas too warm (and too wet) for any accumulation. The lagoon has frozen over at times in history, but not in living memory. Sea temperatures are for the waters of the Adriatic, off the Lido. The waters of the lagoon are warmer, but are heavily polluted. During the warmer months, your nose will easily dissuade you from any contact with the city's many canals. During the cooler months, the prevailing winds are largely from the north and west, down the valley of the Po River. During the warmer ones, they reverse and blow off the Adriatic and up the valley. This brings a welcome coolness and change of air to the city.
