SUNSHINE GUIDE TO VICENZA AND THE ALPINE FOOTHILLS, ITALY

LOCATION: Vicenza, the capital of the province of the same name, is located in northeastern Italy. The city lies some 20 miles northwest of Padua, and twice that northwest of Venice. It is situated at the junction of the Bacchiliglione and Retrone Rivers. Elevations are close to sea level, but the volcanic peak of Monte Berici rises more than a thousand feet just southwest of town. Vincenza is noted for its excellent examples of Palladian architecture.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine occurs on 45% of the year's daylight hours. This ranges from a low of 22% in December, to a high of 63% in July. The expected low temperature for the year will be around 16° at some windless winter sunrise, and the high will be near 93° on some sunny summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be essentially the same as actual ones. The famous fogs of the Po Valley cover Vicenza with a vengeance. More than half the year's days get some fog. This usually burns off by noon, but can also hand around for days at a time—closing the airport and making driving hazardous and sightseeing difficult.

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
