SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE VERONA AREA, ITALY

LOCATION: Verona, the literary home of Shakespeare's entirely fictional Romeo and Juliet, is located in the Alpine foothills of northeastern Italy. The extremely pleasant city is situated along the banks of the River Adige, just at the point that the river emerges from the foothills to join the great Po Valley. The Old City lies within a loop of the river. Verona sits at an elevation of some 220 feet above sea level. It is the capital of its own province, and is part of the region of the Veneto. Lake Garda is only a few miles to the northwest. Verona is considered to be one of the most beautiful cities in Italy, but is often overlooked by travelers to the region in favor of the much better known and celebrated Venice, to the southeast.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 49% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 29% in November, to a high of 66% in July and August. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 17° on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 94° on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be the same as actual ones–except during the spring and autumn, when they are a degree or two cooler. Verona's climate is closer to that of Switzerland and central Europe than it is the south of Italy. Precipitation is at least adequate in every month, with a slight early summer maximum. The area shares in the notorious fogginess of the Po Valley, one of the foggiest places on earth. This fog can close the airport for days on end, and makes driving a nightmare. Take the train.
