SUNSHINE GUIDE TO TAMPICO AND THE HUASTECA, MEXICO

LOCATION: Tampico, Mexico's busiest port, is located on the Gulf of Mexico in the extreme southeastern corner of the state of Tamulipas. The city is situated on the marshy banks of the Rio Panuco, not too far from its mouth. Elevations are close to sea level. Inland, in the fertile area between the coastal plain and the foothills of the Sierra Madre Oriental, is the Huasteca Region.. This has been the homeland of the Huastec people for over 3,000 years. During the 1920's, this was the world's premier oil port, and is still a lively place.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 52% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 37% in January, to a high of 61% in June. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 41°, and the highest should be near 98°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 10° warmer than actual ones because of the combination of temperature and humidity. The winter rains tend to be frontal in nature, and are more persistent but much lighter than the brief intense summer showers. August gets almost four times as much rain as January, but has only half as many rainy hours.
