## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE BRISBANE AREA (QUEENSLAND), AUSTRALIA

LOCATION: Brisbane, the capital and primate city of Queensland, is located on Australia's eastern coast, facing the Coral Sea. The city is situated on the banks of the Brisbane River, where it empties into Moreton Bay. Elevations in the city are close to sea level, with Mount D'Aguilar rising to some 2,444 feet in elevation to the northwest of the city.

COMMENTS: Brisbane lies within the Humid Sub-Tropics, and has essentially a two-season year. Frost has been known to occur, but is extremely rare. Rainfall is at least adequate in every month in most years. The high-sun season (late October through the middle of April) has somewhat longer days, more sunshine than cloud, hot afternoons, mild to warm nights, more frequent rainy days, and more rain when it does come. Afternoon humidities range from moderate to moderately-high. Very hot days are most likely when the winds are from the west and the desert interior. The low-sun season (mid-April through mid-October) has shorter days, a higher percentage of daily sunshine, more clear days, mild to warm afternoons, cool nights, less frequent rain, and less rain when it doe fall. Afternoon humidities range from moderate to moderately-low. The coldest temperatures will probably occur just about sunrise following a clear night in July.
