## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO CAIRNS AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF, AUSTRALIA

LOCATION: Cairns is located on the Coral Sea Coast of Queensland, in northeastern Australia. Just offshore is the northern portion of the Great Barrier Reef. Elevations in Cairns are close to sea level, although the escarpment of the Atherton Plateau rises almost a mile higher just a bit west of town. Mangrove swamps border the town at each end, and the sea offshore is quite shallow.

COMMENTS: Cairns residents see the year as having two seasons, a very wet one and a relatively dry one. The rainy season runs from the middle of December through the end of April. It features higher temperatures, higher humidity, more clouds, less sunshine, and much more rain. The dry season runs from May through early December. It has lower temperatures, more sunshine, less rain, and masses of tourists--both Australians and foreigners. Below-freezing temperatures are unknown. Although there are differences in the averages, the weather on any given day of the year could occur in any month. Tropical storms reach this coast once or twice a year, usually during the rainy season. They can bring extremely heavy rains and destructive flooding. Except during these storms, rainfall will be lighter and shorter out on the Reef islands, and heavier and longer back on the Plateau.

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
