SUNSHINE GUIDE TO PALO ALTO AND THE SOUTH BAY AREA, CALIFORNIA

LOCATION: The pleasant city of Palo Alto is located in Santa Clara County in northern California. The city is situated on the southwestern shores of San Francisco Bay, south of the Dumbarton Bridge. The Bay shore here is flat, marshy, and taken up with sizeable salt evaporation ponds. The land slopes up through the city and its suburbs to the San Andreas Rift Zone and the Santa Cruz Mountains. Elevations within the city itself are within a few hundred feet of sea level. Palo Alto is noted as the site of *Stanford University*.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 62% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 45% in cloudy January, to a high of 79% in sunny July. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 25 at some clear and calm winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 101 on some equally clear and windless summer afternoon. Clear skies and calm airs tend to make the high temperatures higher and the low ones lower. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be essentially the same as actual ones. The area has a maritime version of the Mediterranean-type climate, with its winter rains and summer droughts. The presence of the Bay on one side and the Pacific Ocean only a few miles away on the other, keeps temperatures rather moderate compared to stations at the same latitude farther inland. A foggy day in the table is one in which—at some time of day—an object a half-mile away is invisible due to the fog. Anything more transparent than that is considered merely haze or mist. Local sunshine, temperatures, and humidity vary from site to site, depending upon how much fog and low cloud that particular site gets. This, in turn, is dependent upon distance from the Bay, elevation, and peculiarities of local topography.
