SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE SAN LUIS OBISPO AREA, CALIFORNIA

DESCRIPTION: San Luis Obispo is located near the Pacific Coast of southern California, just about half way between the Los Angeles area and the San Francisco Bay area. The city is situated in the valley of the San Luis Obispo River, about eight miles inland from San Luis Obispo Bay, where a number of satellite beach towns may be found. The valley is bordered on the northeast by the Santa Lucia Range, and on the southwest by the Irish Hills. This pleasant college town (Cal Poly) is centered about the **San Luis Obispo de Tolosa Mission** founded in 1771 by Father Junipero Serra. Elevations are some 325 feet above sea level. The **Santa Lucia Wilderness** of the **Los Padres National Forest** is only a few miles away to the northeast.

CLIMATE: Bright sunshine is likely on 69% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a low of 58% in January and February, to a high of 77% in sunny August and September. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to 26 at some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 97 on some equally clear and windless summer afternoon. Clear skies and calm airs tend to make the high temperatures higher and the low ones lower. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be essentially the same as actual ones. About half the days of the year are clear, with all of them getting at least 40% clear days. Like most of the California coast, SLO is subject to winds from off the Pacific bringing fog and low cloud. In the summer, these move in late at night, and usually don't burn off until the late morning. This fog and cloud cover keeps the nights and winters from getting as cold as they otherwise might, and keeps the days and the summers from getting as hot as they otherwise might. Local climates vary somewhat, depending on distance from the sea, elevation, and local peculiarities of topography.
