COMMENTS: The area has a mid-latitude four-season year, with short hot summers and long cold winters. The sun shines on 64% of the year's daylight hours, ranging from 81% in July down to 41% in December. You can expect the low temperature for the year to be in the neighborhood of -14°F, and to occur some clear January morning when an Arctic air mass has the state in its grip. The high temperature for the year should be close to 99°, and should be reached some sunny and windless July afternoon. Summer afternoons are typically very sunny and hot. Afternoon humidities will be low, and the sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be about three degrees cooler than the actual ones as a consequence. Summer nights are usually cool and dry. Winter afternoons are usually cloudy, humid, and quite cold. A third or more of the afternoons will remain below freezing. Winter nights are almost always below freezing, and below-zero temperature will occur several times each winter. Most of the winter precipitation comes as snow, but it rarely stays on the ground for more than a few days at a time.
