

SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE EVANSVILLE AREA, INDIANA

LOCATION: Evansville is located in the southwestern corner of Indiana. The city is situated on the northern bank of a sharp northern loop (an "oxbow") in the Ohio River. It is a hub of river, rail, and road transportation. The land is level to gently rolling, with elevations around 400 feet above sea level. Across the river lies Kentucky. Much of the area's outdoor recreation activities focus on the river.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 60% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 42% in December, to a high of 75% in July. The year's lowest temperature should be close to -2°, and the highest should be near 99°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be pretty much the same as actual ones for most of the year, and a degree or two warmer than actual ones during the summer months. The area has four distinct seasons, with most of the area's resident considering late summer and autumn to have the nicest weather. Summers are sunny, hot, and moderately sunny. Winters are somewhat cloudy, chilly to cold, and damp. Four out of five winter days will have afternoons that warm to above freezing. Snowfall is highly variable from year to year, and falls rarely remain on the ground for very long.
