SUNSHINE GUIDE TO CAMDEN AND PENOBSCOT BAY, MAINE

LOCATION: Camden is located on the west coast of Penobscot Bay, in south-central Maine. The town is situated in a scenic location, on the coast, at the foot of low mountains. As a port, elevations within the town itself are close to sea level; but Mount Megunticook rises some 1,380 feet in elevation just outside of town in Camden Hills State Park. The town is a popular four-season resort area, with a focus on water-based activities.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 56% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 44% in November, to a high of 62% in July and August. The year's lowest temperature should be close to -14° at sunrise during some winter cold spell, and the highest should be near 93° on some windless July afternoon. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be pretty much the same as actual ones. Snow usually covers the ground from the middle of December through the middle of March-longer away from the coastline. This cover is not continuous, as short thaws bare the ground from time to time. Snowfall is extremely variable from one year to another. Water temperatures are for open waters, away from local streams and rivers.
