SUNSHINE GUIDE TO ELY AND THE GREAT BASIN, NEVADA

LOCATION: Ely, the county seat of Ely County, is located in east-central Nevada. Ely is situated in one of the high sagebrush-covered valleys of the Great Basin province. North/South-trending mountain ranges runs both east and west of town, rising to more than 11,000 feet above sea level. Ely's elevation is around 6,300 feet. Ely is a good base of operations for visits to Great Basin National Park, some seventy miles to the east of town. Nearby Humboldt National Forest offers camping, hiking, climbing, riding and pack-trips, fishing, and hunting. Railway buffs can visit the Nevada Northern Railway Museum, and take weekend excursions on both steam and diesel trains

COMMENTS: The area has a mid-latitude high-desert climate. The sun shines on 73% of the year's daylight hours, ranging from a "low" of 66% in December, to a high of 81% in June. Temperatures vary widely from one season to another. You can expect to encounter sunrise temperatures of -17°F some frigid January morning and to experience temperatures in the middle 90's under a July sun. Sensible temperatures on summer afternoons are up to 5°F cooler than actual ones, due to the low afternoon humidities. Summer nights are quite chilly, and feel even cooler due to that same lack of humidity and the clear night skies. Summer afternoon thunderstorms in the nearby mountains can be heard quite clearly, but rarely bring much if any rain to the city.
