SUNSHINE GUIDE TO PIOCHE AND CATHEDRAL GORGE, NEVADA

LOCATION: Pioche is located in southeastern Nevada. The town is situated in the sagebrush plains of the upper drainage of Meadow Valley Wash, which is dry most of the year. North-south mountain ranges parallel it to both the east and the west. Elevations are about 6,200 feet above sea level. Nearby are Cathedral Gorge State Park, Echo Canyon State Recreation Area, and Spring Valley State Park. The town itself has a pleasant quiet that belies its hell-roaring past. It is quite off the beaten track, which many find to be an attraction in itself.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 76% of the daylight hours of the year. This might range from a "low" of 67% in December, to a high of 87% in June. The lowest temperature of the year should be close to -1° on some calm and clear winter sunrise, and the highest should be near 105° on some sunny and windless summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 5° cooler than actual ones, due to the low humidity. Summers are hot, sunny, and dry. Winters are cold, sunny, and dry. About a dozen winter afternoons will fail to warm to above the freezing point, and below freezing temperatures will occur in every month from late September through May. The best weather comes in June and September.
