SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE WOODSTOCK AREA, NEW YORK

LOCATION: Woodstock is located in southeastern New York. The town is situated along the western side of the broad reaches of the Hudson River Valley, up against the lower fringe of the Catskill Mountains. Elevations are some 500 feet above sea level. The town is noted as an artist's colony.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine occurs on 50% of the year's daylight hours. This ranges from a low of 34% in cloudy December, to a high of 61% in sunny July. The expected low temperature for the year will be around -12° at some windless winter sunrise, and the high will be near 95° on some sunny summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be essentially the same as actual ones. The area gets the standard mid-latitude four-season year, with winter as the dominant season. The ground will be frozen and frequently snow-covered from late November through late March.
