SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE HURON AREA, SOUTH DAKOTA

LOCATION: Huron is located in the central part of eastern South Dakota. It is an administrative, processing, and market center for the surrounding agricultural area. The landscape is essentially a level one, very much part of the Great Plains. The surrounding area offers fishing for walleye and northern pike in the many small lakes in the area, and hunting for upland birds (especially pheasant) in the nearby fields. Elevations are some 1,300 feet above sea level.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 63% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 50% in December, to a high of 76% in July. The year's lowest temperature should be close to -26°, and the highest should be near 102°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be essentially the same as actual ones. Huron's four seasons are quite distinct, although spring is fairly short. All of the seasons are marked by abrupt day to day changes in the weather—often hour to hour. Most residents feel that late summer and autumn are the most pleasant times of year. Blizzards are a fact of life on the Great Plains, but most years pass without a true one in the Huron area. Winter days with high winds (the area is a fairly windy one), blowing snow, and poor visibility are more common. On the other hand, two out of five winter days are sunny with temperatures above freezing. Canny residents enjoy the latter while being fully prepared for the former.
