SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE GALVESTON AREA, TEXAS

LOCATION: Galveston is located in southeastern Texas. The small city is situated on Galveston Island, some three miles offshore of Galveston Bay. It is tied to the mainland by a bridge carrying I-45. Once the largest city in Texas, it is now a thriving resort community. Its major attractions are its miles of sandy beaches and its restored Victorian-era buildings. Elevations are close to sea level—very close. In 1900 a massive and powerful hurricane utterly destroyed the city, leaving some 6,000 people dead—the most lives lost in any U. S. hurricane.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 62% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 47% in January, to a high of 75% in June. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 27°, and the highest should be near 95°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you feel) will be up to two degrees cooler than actual ones during the cooler months, and up to seven degrees warmer than actual ones during the heat of summer. Winters are mild, with below-freezing temperatures only occurring when the rest of the country is dominated by frigid Arctic air masses. Summers are hot and humid. The nicest seasons are spring (especially April and May) and autumn (especially October). The area has one chance in seven of getting a hurricane during the entire hurricane season (July through September) in any given year.
