SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE SALT LAKE CITY METROPOLITAN AREA, UTAH

LOCATION: Salt Lake City, Utah's capital and largest city, is located in the north-central part of that state. The city is situated on the lower slopes of the western face of the Wasatch Mountains, between those mountains and the southern end of the Great Salt Lake. Elevations in the central city are about 4,400 feet above sea level, with the suburbs both sloping up the mountains and down toward the lake.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 65% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 43% in December, to a high of 81% in July. The year's lowest temperature should be close to -3°, and the highest should be near 102°. Sensible summer afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be up to 6° cooler than actual ones. Temple Square should be your first stop. It features the Temple (closed to non-Mormons), the Tabernacle, and a number of other historic buildings, all enclosed within a 15-foot wall. Guided tours are available. Outside of town, four world-class ski resorts can be reached by city bus (ski racks provided). Many skiers find it cheaper and more fun to stay in the city and take a bus to their resort choice of the day. The Great Salt Lake is a mere shadow of its former self. Its size varies with the previous winter's precipitation.
