SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE TACOMA AREA, WASHINGTON

LOCATION: Tacoma is located in west-central Washington. The city is situated at the south end of Commencement Bay, an arm of Puget Sound. Elevations are everywhere close to sea level. On clear days, Mount Rainier, some forty miles southeast, dominates the horizon.

COMMENTS: The area has a temperate marine version of the mid-latitude four-season year. Summers are sunny, dry, and warm. Winters are cloudy, wet, and chilly. Bright sunshine occurs on 44% of the year's daylight hours, ranging from a low of 19% in December to a high of 62% in July. The low temperature for the year will be near 17° some windless winter sunrise, while the high will be around 91° some sunny summer afternoon. Precipitation is moderate, with most of it coming as rain during the winter months. A typical summer afternoon will be long, sunny, moderately humid, rainless, and warm rather than hot. Summer nights tend to be clear and cool. A typical winter afternoon will be short, cloudy, very humid, probably rainy, and chilly. Winter nights are cold, damp, and often wet. Winter rains are far more common than winter snows, and the ground rarely stays snow-covered past noon of the next day--especially in the city.
