SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE APOSTLE ISLANDS NATIONAL LAKESHORE, WISCONSIN

LOCATION: The Apostle Islands are a group of 21 islands off the tip of Wisconsin's Bayfield Peninsula in southwestern Lake Superior. Twenty of the islands are under federal management as part of the National Lakeshore. The largest of the islands, Madeline, is not. Is consists of private holdings. Elevations are close to 800 feet above sea level. Access to the islands is by boat only. There is summer ferry service.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine occurs on 49% of the year's daylight hours, ranging from a low of 30% in November to a high of 64% in July. The low temperature for the year will be near -22° some windless winter sunrise, while the high will be around 93° some sunny summer afternoon. Precipitation is light, and is concentrated during the summer months. Surrounded by the cool waters of Lake Superior, all the seasons are delayed by a few weeks over what is usually the case farther inland. Lakes (but not the deeper waters of Lake Superior) and streams freeze up in late November, and don't "break up" until early April.
