## SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE ISLAND OF MONTSERRAT, BRITISH WEST INDIES

LOCATION: The island and British Crown Colony of Montserrat is located in the Leeward Islands portion of the Lesser Antilles. Its nearest neighbors are Nevis, about thirty miles to the northwest, Antigua some twenty-five miles to the northeast, and Guadeloupe lying about forty miles to the southeast. Elevations range from sea level to almost three-thousand feet above it at the summit of Chances Peak.

COMMENTS: The area has a vague two-season year based on precipitation. There is a rainy season, and a not-so-rainy season. Bright sunshine occurs on 63% of the year's daylight hours, ranging from a "low" of 60% in rainy July, to a high of 67% in the January high season. Both islands and mountains generate their own clouds, and this mountainous island has a pretty steady cloud cap. The low temperature for the year will be near 63° some windless winter sunrise, while the high will be around 93° some sunny summer afternoon. Sensible temperatures (the ones you actually feel) range from 2° (January) to 8° (July) hotter than the ones shown on the thermometer because of high humidities. Hurricanes come close enough to cause concern about one year in three. Montserrat's mountainous spine offers pretty good protection to the leeward, western side.
