SUNSHINE GUIDE TO THE ISLAND OF TRINIDAD, TRINIDAD & TOBAGO

LOCATION: The island of Trinidad is located in the Atlantic Ocean just fifteen miles off the northeast coast of Venezuela. Trinidad can be considered the most southerly of the islands of the Caribbean, although geologically it is an offshoot of the South American mainland. The island occupies 1,864 square miles. Elevations range from sea level to 3,087 feet above it at the summit of Cerro del Aripo.

COMMENTS: Bright sunshine is likely on 58% of the year's daylight hours. This might range from a low of 49% in June, to a high of 67% in February. The year's lowest temperature should be close to 63°, and the highest should be near 94°. Sensible afternoon temperatures (the ones you actually feel) will be from 3° to 10° warmer than actual ones. Trinidad shares the familiar two-season tropical year with many of the other islands. The two seasons are set apart by the frequency and intensity of rainfall. The rainy season runs from late May in most year through early December. The less rainy season extends from the middle of December (usually) through the middle of May (most years). Considerable variation should be expected from year-to-year in both the timing and intensity of these two seasons.
